ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Steti Transport Ltd. provides aggregates throughout the Bulkley Valley, with a focus on quality products and excellent customer service.

Aggregate Truck Drivers work in the Aggregate Operations team, but also independently. Drivers load and haul aggregates for customers, from small residential deliveries to on-site work for major industrial operations. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Loading your truck, weighing and recording aggregate deliveries, and completing deliveries.
- On-site hauling for a variety of contracts, both large and small.
- Ensuring customer service excellence timely deliveries, professional customer interactions, etc.
- Coordinating with the dispatcher on deliveries and your schedule.
- Maintaining a clean vehicle and basic maintenance (ex: keep inside cab clean, truck wash, greasing, etc.).
- Compliance with Steti's Safety Program and relevant regulations for driving and pit activities.
- Dependent on qualifications and ability, additional work options may become available.

QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

- Class 1 BCDL with airbrakes and a clean driver's abstract.
- Trucking experience (Steti trucks range from single-axle to tridem with tridem pup).
- Basic ability to run a loader our drivers load their trucks.
